[Jeremiah Holmes is recorded as attending the Leet Court 1709, 1710, 1711, 1714, 1719, 1721, 1723 and 1725. In 1721 he was elected Constable. In 1717 he and Frances Goodale were married. They were both described as having been married before and were both from Castle Rising. No Holmes children were recorded as baptised between 1717 and 1725. Frances was the widow of William Goodale, who was the miller of the Upper Mill. William had died in 1711. He too was an intermittent attendant at the Leet Court, from 1693 to 1710. He was constable in 1707. His Will is preserved in NRO (O.W.3/34) where he is described a paper-maker. He must therefore have been Miller at the Upper Mill. William Goodale had married Frances (nee Kendal) in 1708. He was already a widow when he married Frances. Probably Frances was a daughter of Simon Kendal, who had attended the Leet Court on many occasions between 1681 and 1707.

Daniel Riches attended the Leet Court for only 3 years, 1724 to 1726.

Robert Dodding is the same person whose inventory we already have and was Mayor of CR.]
